

## Film Highlights Conference

### Water Management Experts Meet

The Cities Service film, "Pure Water . . . The Best of Gifts" highlighted the second conservation conference jointly sponsored by the company and the Conservation Council of Ontario in London on October 19. It was the first time the film was released to the public.

Major speakers on water management from Canada and the United States discussed the latest aspects of water availability and pollution. Two official "discussants" were appointed to dispute various aspects of each paper presented before the topic was thrown open to the floor for general questions. Mr. Ralph Harris, the company-sponsored speaker on Conservation, was a discussant.

The new 16 mm. colour film dramatising the management of water and the control of pollution received unanimous acclaim from the assembled experts in this field.
